ATHLETES

TEAM SUPPORT GRANTS

Aim: To support one national team (men OR women; hockey OR another sport) per country in

their preparation for:

- the Beijing Olympic Games

World Championships (senior and junior)Continental Championships (senior and junior)

The Olympic QualifierMulti Sports Games

OS-budget: 9 Million US\$ for the period 2005-2008

NOC budget: dependent on the NOC proposal

Advice to NA: encourage your NOC to select your national men's or women's team for a grant

COACHES

TECHNICAL COURSES FOR COACHES

Aim: To provide basic level training to coaches (or level 2/3 training in case of a regional

course), led by an expert from another country

OS-budget: 13 Million US\$ for the period 2005-2008

NOC budget: maximum 80.000 US\$ for a maximum of 10 courses

Advice to NA: encourage your NOC to include one or several hockey coaching courses (playing and/or

umpiring) in their planning and budget

OLYMPIC SCHOLARSHIPS FOR COACHES

Aim: To offer (national) coaches access to high level or further training, (either in sports science

or in sports specific training), which they will use to benefit their respective national sports

structures.

OS-budget: 6 Million US\$ for the period 2005-2008

NOC budget: 1 scholarship per NOC per year

Advice to NA: encourage your NOC to select a hockey (national) coach for a scholarship

DEVELOPMENT OF NATIONAL SPORTS STRUCTURES

Aim: To allow NOCs to develop their national sport- and coaching structure by implementing a

mid-to-long term action plan for a specific sport. This is to include the visit of a high level coach / development expert, who is experienced in setting up sport- and coaching

structures, for a period of 3-6 months.

OS-budget: 5 Million US\$ for the period 2005-2008

NOC budget: 20,000 – 25,000 US\$ per project

Advice to NA: encourage your NOC to include hockey in the NOCs planning and budget by providing the

NOC with a long term development (action) plan for hockey, which includes the visit of a

FIH expert for 3-6 months

PROMOTION OF OLYMPIC VALUES

SPORTS MEDICINE

Aim: To develop and share scientific knowledge & techniques in sports medicine by educating

doctors, physiotherapists, trainers and coaches with practical and clinical scientific training in sports medicine. This can be achieved with the use of courses, scholarship programs

and publications.

OS-budget: 2,7 Million US\$ for the period 2005-2008

NOC budget: dependent on the NOC proposal

Advice to NA: encourage your NOC to select and invite recommended hockey trainers, coaches, doctors

and physiotherapists for courses, scholarships and publications

WOMEN AND SPORT

Aim: To encourage NOCs to reinforce, launch and implement activities to promote awareness

and increase participation of women in sport, both in practice and in administration

OS-budget: 1,2 Million US\$ for the period 2005-2008

NOC budget: dependent on the NOC proposal

Advice to NA: encourage your NOC to:

a) select and invite hockey representatives for world- and continental seminars

b) include hockey initiatives for women & sport in the NOC planning and budget

SPORT FOR ALL

Aim: To promote sport in general, and the practice of physical activity throughout all levels of

society.

OS-budget: 1,9 Million US\$ for the period 2005-2008

NOC budget: contribution to the organisational costs of the Olympic Day Run & to individual initiatives at

national level. Contribution dependent on the NOC proposal

Advice to NA: encourage your NOC to:

c) select and invite hockey representatives for national seminars

d) include hockey initiatives on sport for all in the NOC planning and budget

NATIONAL TRAINING COURSES FOR SPORTS ADMINISTRATORS

Aim: To offer NOC's the opportunity to organise national training courses to improve the

knowledge of administrators and to strengthen the management of Olympic Sports Organisations through: a) Standard Sports Administration Courses

b) Advanced Sports Management Courses

OS-budget: 2,5 Million US\$ for the period 2005-2008

NOC budget: 2000 US\$ towards the organisation of each approved NOC course

Advice to NA: encourage your NOC to select and invite hockey administrators for the standard and

advanced courses
